

Configure Delivery Settings In the **Bundle Template Editor** section, under the **Delivery Settings** tab, open the bundle template. Configure the settings as shown. Contact MGIC Integration Services for the production Connect Host, Auth Username and Auth Password if needed. Standard Default SFTP port will be used if blank: 22 Click Update. Private Key Data

#### 3. Configure Custom Properties

The **Custom Properties** tab has various custom fields you'll need to configure. Assign default values to the fields that remain the same from loan to loan.


Click Update.



#### 4. Create Document Stack


In the **Document Stack Editor** section, select the documents to add to the list and indicate the category and whether it's required or not.
